Punctuality

Please make sure you arrive at the studio at least 10mins before class starts. It is very disruptive to you, the other students and the teacher when students continually wander into class late. If for some reason it is impossible for you to arrive on time please inform the teacher so that arrangements can be made to have you enter with as little disruption as possible.

Grooming

We stress the importance of good grooming for young people studying dance. Looking one's best aids self esteem, promotes confidence and gives pride in performance.

Ballet

- Leotard, tights and shoes should be well fitted.
- Underpants should not be worn. The tights act as the undergarment.
- No large jewelry pieces should be worn.
- The hair should be neatly groomed and appropriately styled off the face and neck in a bun, secured with a hairnet and bobby pins.

For our younger ballerina's who need help with their hair please speak to the office and we will arrange a hair buddy. You must provide your own hairbrush, hairnet and pins and arrive at the studio in plenty of time.

Dress

Level	Leotard	Shoes	Tights / Socks	Other
Pre-Primary	Pink	Pink	Pink tights or pink ankle socks	Can where a pink sheer skirt. Length 2-3" above the knee
Primary	Light Blue	Pink	Pink tights or pink ankle socks	Can where a blue sheer skirt. Length 2-3" above the knee
Grade1 -5	Navy Blue	Pink Full Sole	Pink tights	Character shoes and skirt rented from DIM
Grade 6-8	Navy Blue	Pink Fullsole or split sole	Pink Tights	Character shoes and skirt. Chiffon Skirt and silk scarf - Rented from DIM

******The leotard colours listed above are recommended colours and will be required for ballet examinations. Any solid coloured leotard is acceptable for class.******
